THE PRO ACT WILL:

- Strengthen strikes and other protest activity: The bill will make it illegal for employers to permanently replace striking workers and make secondary strikes and boycotts legal.
- Make it easier to bargain: The bill will eliminate obstacles for workers to get their first contact and deals a blow to so-called "right-to-work" laws.
- Make companies pay for retaliating against workers: The bill will establish stiff penalties for employers who fire or retaliate against workers for forming a union or speaking out about their working conditions.

And much more!

It's time for our elected officials to show us whose side they are really on. They need to stop handing control to CEOs and billionaires and give us the freedom to determine our own futures.
